Specimen Requirements: 1 EDTA vacutainer less than 24 hrs.old.

EXPOSURE PANEL EMPLOYEE

Includes: HIV-1/HIV-2 screen and Hepatitis B surface antibody (HBsAb).

Specimen Requirements: 1 SST tube (unopened, spun)
Avoid hemolysis. Obtain informed consent before collection.
Physicians name must be on requisition.

Reference Range:

HIV	negative
HBsAB	positive (indicates immunity)

Confirmatory Western Blot test done if HIV is positive or indeterminate by EIA.

Report Time: 24-96 hours; if confirmation by Western Blot is required to confirm the HIV-1/HIV-2 screen, results will be reported in 10 - 14 days. (State Lab)

EXPOSURE PANEL SOURCE

Includes: HIV-1/HIV-2 screen Hepatitis B surface antigen (HBsAg), and HCV (Hepatitis C Antibody).

Specimen Requirements: 2 SST tubes (unopened, spun)
Avoid hemolysis. Obtain informed consent before collection.
Physicians name must be on requisition.

Reference Range: HIV negative

Confirmatory Western Blot test done if HIV is positive or indeterminate by EIA.

HBsAg negative

Confirmatory Neutralization test done if HBsAg is positive by EIA..

HCV negative

Confirmatory PCR testing is done if HCV is positive by EIA.

Report Time: 24-96 hours; if confirmation by Western Blot is required to confirm the HIV-1/HIV-2 screen, results will be reported in 10 - 14 days. (State Lab) If confirmation by Neutralization is required to confirm the HBsAg, results reported in 10-14 days. (State Lab) If confirmation by PCR is required for HCV, results will be reported in 3-5 days. (Quest)
